- The visit should allow the applicant to create contact with a research active institution, and during the week visit, the student should gain experience of the research program at the host department. The visit may for example also provide an opportunity to participate in some research eg an inter-observer study with appropriate permissions.
- After the visit it is hoped the student will maintain contact with the department as they develop their research career.
